

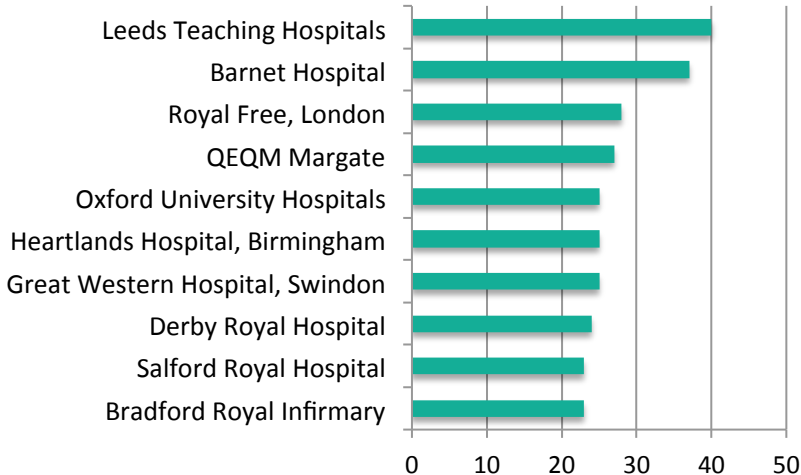

### NASBO Quick Stats:

- 131 sites now registered on REDCap across UK
- 324 collaborators working on NASBO across four nations
- 408 operations for SBO so far
- Nobody has beaten our oldest patient to date at 101 years
- Our lightest patient is just 28.8 kg
- Over one in five patients has acute kidney injury on admission
